We are looking for a PIMH Co-ordinator to join our team and build on our existing PIMH work, to deliver support for parents in Stockport during the peri-natal period. The successful candidate will work closely with colleagues from Parent Infant Mental Health Services, Maternity & Health Visiting supporting a wide range parents with children aged 0-2. They will be responsible for recruiting, training and managing a team of volunteers and for promoting parent-infant mental health across the borough. An understanding of the risks of developing poor mental health in the 0-2 period, known as 1001 critical days, is essential.

We are looking for someone with a creative approach to the work and the potential to develop their self-reflective practice through supervision, training and experience. We would expect the ideal candidate to grow into this role over time guided by a full package of training, specialist clinical support and guidance from an already established PIMH's team at HOST. This is a great learning opportunity to develop skills within this role, working alongside PIMH's clinicians, families and volunteers
