

Employment Positions at Home-Start Rochdale Borough

As a result of new funding becoming available through the CCG, the Directors of Home-Start Rochdale Borough are able to advertise the following positions of employment.

CHILDRENS SUPPORT WORKER FOR AUTISM, ADHD AND DISABILITIES (3 POSTS)

Hours of work: 37 hours each week, usually working Monday to Friday. There may be the occasional early mornings, teatime, weekend or evening work, so flexibility is required.

Job share may be considered.

Salary: £21,255

The worker must be available to evidence how they can support the delivery of:

Home Visiting Support – For families experiencing Autism, ADHD and disabilities with children under the age of 12 years, living throughout the Borough of Rochdale.

Provide emotional and practical support for 50 families by home visiting support where children have social, communication, behavioural difficulties or disabilities, with or without a diagnosis.

Sibs Support Group – This group is delivered for a period of 6-8 weeks usually twice per year. This will involve working late until approximately 8pm.

Group Support for Families – To set up and prepare the room, you would need to be available from 8am for one day every other week.

The support worker will support the RAASS Manager to deliver a range of support opportunities for families, including group sessions across the borough of Rochdale.

Support, information and guidance provided to enable families to increase their engagement within community services appropriate to their level of need.

Work alongside the RAASS Manager to deliver Group Support Sessions for families.

Reassure parents and provide emotional support throughout the duration of their support, providing a listening ear and understanding.

Introduce various coping strategies for parents to improve their resilience and reduction in accessing higher-level services.

Making referrals to other services when required.

Requirements:

Ideally, the Worker will have experience of living with a person on the Autistic Spectrum or ADHD. Alternatively, this person will be able to evidence their ability to learn at a fast pace.

At least level two in a childcare / equivalent related subject is required.

The person will have at least 12 months experience of supporting families with complex support needs.

Have a wealth of experience and knowledge of Autism, ADHD and other related conditions or have the willingness to train and learn.

Other requirements

A car driver, business use insurance and use of own car is essential for this post.

All opportunities will be on a short-term contract from 4th April 2022 – 31st March 2023.

Positions are not term time only and you must be able to work flexibly to meet the needs of the service.

Candidates MUST be fully vaccinated by the start date proposed for the 4th April 2022.

Closing dates for all positions Friday 21st January 2022 at 9am.

Interview dates Monday 28th February 2022.
